Our Child Development Center is committed to providing dedicated developmental care for children in our community with disabilities. Our small setting program serves children birth to age 5 where we assist families with preventive health care, serve as a liaison between a child's physician and the school, implement therapy and early intervention plans in the classroom setting. We use The Creative Curriculum for Preschool which is a comprehensive research-based curriculum that features exploration and discovery as a way of learning.

Our teachers modify their classroom curriculum as needed such that each child receives specialized instruction which meets their unique needs. Each child is screened for delays upon enrollment and at their birth month using the Ages and Stages Questionnaires (ASQ). Based on these ASQ's and any additional information provided by the family, physician or therapist, goals are created. The teachers work collaboratively with therapists and families to support success in reaching goals and developmental milestones.



Committed to Care

Our Blooming Buddies Classroom specializes in child development for those children ages Birth to five who have moderate to severe disabilities and thus need more intensive care. The children's health is monitored by a full-time Certified Nursing Assistant and their educational development is furthered by the Teacher who has more than 20 years of experience with special needs children. We also maintain a 1:4 teacher/student ratio.

Our Tiny Tots Classroom focuses on the development of children with special needs who are between the ages of 1 and 3 while our Krusin' Kids educate our Pre-K population ages 3-5. Both classrooms offer a low teacher/student ratio, wide variety of activities, in addition to a nurturing environment.
